Our View on Andermatt





Andermatt sits in the cultural and geographical heart of the Swiss Alps. The charming resort is made up of narrow streets lined with traditional chalets. Surrounded by the Adula Alps, the ski region is well connected to the neighbouring resorts including Sedrun. Home to the notorious Devil's Bridge, Andermatt has plenty of incredible views, especially whilst skiing. One of the most snow-sure resorts in the Alps, you can be sure skiing is always on the cards, especially for those looking to ski off-piste.

Top Runs

- 2a Passtrasse is a long, winding blue that runs directly into Andermatt, making it a great slope for intermediate or confident skiers to finish the day on.
- A long red run that takes you halfway down between Andermatt and Gemstock, Sonnenpiste is 2,961m high. The views of the valley below make this long run truly special.
- The blue run Lochbarake offers fantastic views of Andermatt below.
 You can reach this run directly via the Natschen-Stockli chairlift.
- Felsental is an iconic off-piste run for experts, this drops into a valley at Hospental. The run ends in a series of trees and uneven slopes, meaning it's not for the faint of heart to tackle.





Best for Après Ski

Il Fermento

Expect delicious food as well as drinks in this Beer Hall. The Italian dishes are a real treat in the Alps, with the pasta and pizza options being some of the favourites of visitors.

Vinothek 1620

For a more intimate après, this wine bar is the perfect choice. Taste a variety of delicious wines, situated in what feels like a cosy wine cellar.
