Top Runs

- Prätschli Honigland is a free ski area perfect for children and beginners looking to get some practice. In fact, the Arosa ski region in general is well catered to beginners and intermediates.
- Weisshorn-Arosa is the longest run in the resort at 4.5km. This leads to the Obersee lake, a beautiful view surrounded by mountains.
- Black Diamond Slope is one of the most difficult runs in Arosa, the beautiful panoramic views are the reward for the challenge ahead. The slope becomes extremely steep, making it a natural stop for many thrill-seekers.
