



Crans Montana is a sunshine resort due to its south-facing location. It's also one of the largest ski resorts in Switzerland with access to 140km of pistes. The views wherever you are on the mountain are breathtaking and the resort has something for all levels of skier or snowboarder. Not only is the skiing superb, the resort is also known for its gourmet dining scene. True Swiss bliss!

Top Runs

- Beginners have a dedicated nursery area on the converted Crans golf course. There are also gentle blues to progress from in the Cry d'Er area.
- For intermediates, there's an easy long red run running from the Plaine Morte glacier for 11km. It has fantastic views along the way.
- Advanced skiers can head to the Piste Nationale black run, which is the World Cup downhill slope.
- For those searching for off-piste skiing, Crans Montana has plenty of good terrain to explore with a guide. There are also no less than 10 ungroomed runs on the piste map if you want to enjoy powder inbounds.



Best for Après Ski

- **Amadeus Bar**
Located on the ground floor of the Hotel Olympic, Amadeus Bar is a perfect nightlife spot. The bar has a lively atmosphere and is open 3 pm to 10 pm during the season.
- **New Pub**
The New Pub is a popular après place because of the large TV screen showing live sport, pinball and karaoke nights. It's located near the main lake in the village.
- **Monk's Bar**
Monk's Bar attracts a youthful crowd with themed parties and early après on the panoramic terrace. The bar is open from 7pm until the early hours of morning.
- **Le Tirbouchon**
For a well-deserved glass of wine in the evening, head to Le Tirbouchon. It's a classy bar that also serves local cheeses and meats.

Recommended Restaurants

- **Le Mayen**
Located in the centre of Crans Montana, Le Mayen serves delicious local Valais cuisine. Try Alp cheese, local meats and seasonal dishes.
- **Mosaic**
If you are looking for fine-dining Mosaic is a brilliant choice. The signature dish, spaghetti with lobster, is a must-have. It's located near the tourist office in Montana.
- **Chetzeron**
The Chetzeron is an impressive establishment. The restaurant has been converted from an old cable car station into a modern hotel and restaurant.
- **Burger Lounge**
The best burgers in town. The meat is locally sourced or there's a veggie burger alternative. A great place for families and for those who want a cheaper option to eat.
