



Gressoney is full of iconic mountain views. You can enjoy the incredible scenery of the Dolomites, Mont Blanc, the Gran Paradiso and the Matterhorn. A lot of skiers go to the Italian ski resort for its fantastic off-piste terrain. The ski resort is made up of two main areas Gressoney- La-Trinité and Gressoney-Saint-Jean. Both villages have kept their traditional Italian mountain charm with their rustic Alpine architecture. Enjoy delicious Italian cuisine with stunning backdrops. A beautiful destination with excellent slopes.

Top Runs

- Beginners have a dedicated area at the base of the gondola to Gabiet. There are also a couple of easy blues to enjoy near Cimaletta.
- Intermediates will enjoy the red runs near Seehorn towards Passo Salati at 2,971m on the Alagna side of the valley.
- Advanced skiers can test themselves on the steep black G6 run above Stafal. It's recommended to ski this run in good conditions.
- There are excellent off-piste areas to explore. Punta Indren is the best spot with over 1,000m of off-piste terrain to explore.



Best for Après Ski

- **Castore & Polluce**
At weekends this bar is lively with local Italians. As well as drinks and cocktails, the bar offers 32 flavours of chocolate fondue, should you have a sweet tooth.
- **Bar Sport**
This small family-run bar is a great stop for hot chocolate in the cold, or to watch live sport in the evening. The atmosphere is also very friendly and welcoming.
- **Bar Lyskamm**
This is a cute café in the Gressoney-Saint-Jean area. You can try freshly made sandwiches, focaccia and bresaola, or enjoy delicious gin, cordial or wine.
- **Petit Bar**
Excellent service by a local Italian couple. There's a great selection of local wine to enjoy. It has a quiet, yet welcoming atmosphere.

Recommended Restaurants

- **Punta Jolanda**
This cosy restaurant serves delicious local cuisine. It's your typical traditional mountain restaurant with a relaxed atmosphere.
- **Lo Stambecco**
For the best pizza in town, head to Lo Stambecco. It serves delicious pizza cooked in a fire oven. The pasta dishes are delightful too.
- **La Marmotta**
If you want a beautiful mountain view and excellent food, La Marmotta is perfect. The restaurant serves modern and refined Italian cuisine, as well as some delightful homemade desserts.
- **Snack Bar**
A quiet spot in town to enjoy a drink and tasty food. There's lovely liqueur, wine or Spritz to try, and they serve a variety of dishes.
