Top Runs

- The Bodmi runs are ideal for both children and beginner adults. With a scenic backdrop, they're also a great place to warm up.
- The Oberjoch run, said to be the most beautiful of Grindelwald's runs, starts at the Oberjoch which is the highest point in the ski area, giving you an incredible view of the Swiss Alps. This is a great choice for intermediates to advanced skiers.
- The Schilthorn is the steepest slope in the Jungfrau ski region, so is perfect for experienced intermediates or advanced skiers.
- For expert skiers, there are the Männlichen off-piste runs. They're only advised in good visibility but are the perfect playground for all those powder lovers.
