Our View on La Clusaz





La CluSaZ is part of the Les Aravis skiing area and has something for everybody. The French ski resort has access to 220km of pistes and boasts some fantastic diverse terrain. The village itself has a small mountain town charm, which is unique for a lot of French ski resorts. La Clusaz is brilliant for families, but it also has a lively après scene too. There is a great selection of places to eat in the area. It's no wonder this ski resort is popular with British skiers.

Top Runs

- Beginners can easily access nursery slopes near the village. The green and blue runs at the top of the Beauregard gondola are great to progress on.
- Intermediates can enjoy the steeper red pistes of La Balme. Wide open but steep enough to get a bit of speed.
- There are a few black runs in particular for advanced skiers to try. The Vraille black piste on La Balme is very steep. On L'Etale, the Tetras and Mur d'Edgar are also a good challenge.
- La Balme has some great off-piste skiing on a powder day, and is best explored with a local mountain guide.





Best for Après Ski

Le Relais de l'Aiguille

The evening usually starts with a stop at Le Relais de l'Aiguille bar. It's a popular place after a day on the slopes.

· Le Bachal

A cosy bar in the heart of the town. It has a relaxed and welcoming atmosphere. A great place to unwind after a day on the mountain.

· The S Pub

This pub on the slopes has a large open terrace and a great atmosphere. Not only is it a fun place for a drink, but it also serves delicious food too.

· Chalet des Praz

This bar is an ideal hotspot for après ski. It is 200m above the village. It has lively music and a great selection of drinks.

Recommended Restaurants

La Ferme

This restaurant serves delicious traditional French cuisine. It's a rustic chalet, so you get the full mountain experience.

La Cordée

It's one of the best spots in town to have pizza. As well as this, the restaurant serves traditional French alpine food.

A great place to enjoy a steak and fries. It serves a mixture of cuisine and has very friendly staff.
