## Our View on Lake Louise





Lake Louise is one of Canada's largest ski areas, located in Alberta. It has access to an incredible 4,200 acres of skiable terrain. There is a fantastic amount of long and gentle runs for beginner and intermediate skiers, and expert skiers can enjoy endless chutes, glades and remote bowls. Marvel at the spectacular scenery that Lake Louise offers, backed by the dramatic Rocky mountains.

## **Top Runs**

- Deer Run is a great run for beginners. It is a wide track with great views. From the top of the gondola head to the Eagle Meadows run and take a right. It's the less busy option and equally as fun.
- Old Ptarmigan is a rolling blue piste that runs into the Ptarmigan ski area.
   It is a wonderful treelined slope that is groomed regularly. A perfect run for intermediates in this steep area.
- Eagle Flight is an excellent hidden run into the Eagle Poma ski area. Take the Grizzly Express Gondola, and head to the top of the slope. It is marked as a more advanced ski run and usually has fresh powder.
- Men's Downhill is Lake Louise's World Cup Men's Downhill run.
   There are remarkable views coupled with challenging high-speed black diamonds to get your heart and adrenaline racing.





## Best for Après Ski

- · Fairview Bar
  - This is one of the best places to go for a drink after the slopes. Great service and even better views of the spectacular lake.
- Lake Louise Village Grill & Bar
   A casual setting to unwind
   with your group and is also
   suitable for families. Watch
   the game in the bar area after
   your day of skiing.
- The Outpost Pub
   An English-style pub with a great atmosphere and typical pub grub food if you choose to eat. There's a cosy fireplace and TVs to relax in front of.
- Explorer's Lounge
   This is a great place to grab a cocktail or one of the local draft beers on offer. There is a pool table to challenge your group to a game.
