



**Les Menuires** is in the centre of the Three Valleys in France, one of the largest ski areas in the world. The resort gives access to more than 600km of varied slopes, making it a popular choice for winter sports enthusiasts. Elevated at 1,850m, Les Menuires is considered a snow-sure resort, providing fresh powder and marvellous skiing conditions. When the skis come off, there are plenty of ways to keep busy at the resort. From bustling bars, traditional restaurants, and sumptuous spas, to thrilling toboggan runs, Les Menuires has it all.

## Top Runs

- With access to the Three Valleys ski area, there are plenty of thrilling red and black runs to explore. Head up to Pointe de la Masse for some off-piste adventures, best enjoyed with a guide.
- For intermediates, there are many red runs that flow into cruisy blue slopes above the resort, which also pass through the town. Perfect for taking in the stunning mountain range.
- Beginners' slopes, such as Fontanettes, are well positioned and flow down to La Croisette. These runs are great for new skiers to build confidence away from nursery runs.



## Best for Après Ski

- **Pub Le Challenge**  
A relaxed spot for après skiing, with a pool table and darts board for some friendly competition. The bar hosts live music and poker nights.
- **Le Leeberty**  
A typical French bar and club that plays sing along music and keeps the party going until the early hours.
- **Le Skilt**  
This bar sits at the bottom of the piste, allowing for ski-in ski-out access. There is a large outdoor terrace to enjoy the mountain views with a glass of fizz.

## Recommended Restaurants

- **Le Grand Lac**  
A slopeside restaurant offering warming, hearty meals to hungry skiers. Enjoy some good food and soak up the sun and mountain views on the large terrace.
- **Peuf Daddy 1850**  
This is a great spot if you're looking for real quality French food, with set menus at lunch and dinner you're sure to leave feeling well fed.
- **L'Ours Blanc**  
During the day, L'Ours Blanc is a casual spot for a lunch break on the slopes. In the evening this restaurant offers a gastronomic menu based on regional ingredients.
