Our View on Saalbach-Hinterglemm





Saalbach-Hinterglemm is made up of two neighbouring villages, Saalbach and Hinterglemm, in the beautiful Glemm valley, Austria. With 200km of pisted runs and 55 lifts spread across the valley, the skiing is absolutely first class and an intermediate's dream. Saalbach is the larger of the two villages, with an attractive centre and a lively, traditional atmosphere. Hinterglemm, 4km down the road, is quieter yet still has a good choice of bars and is close to the lifts. Both of the villages are car free and have retained their Tirolean charm with traditional-style buildings and quaint shops.

Top Runs

- The runs from both of the villages make a circuit almost entirely formed of broad, sweeping slopes. Travelling anti-clockwise, it is possible to make a complete circuit on your skis, crossing from one side of the valley to the other at Vorderglemm and Lengau.
- Over 90% of the lifts at Saalbach– Hinterglemm are high speed, which is the highest proportion of fast lifts of any major resort in the world.
- The sunny side of the valley is good for intermediates both looking for a gentle cruise or to push their limits.
 There are some long red runs that are good fun.





Best for Après Ski

Hinterhag Alm

This rustic bar is on the hill above Saalbach. The party starts at 4pm. Live bands and DJs keep the atmosphere lively until it's time to slide back down the mountain.

Bauer's Schi-Alm

Sets the scene for a great night of après ski. Over the top, great fun and a little crazy, this is a Saalbach favourite.

eva.ALM

Right in the centre of Saalbach, the eva,ALM has a great atmosphere thanks to its brilliant, heated terraces and open fireplace.

Zum Turm

An old jail turned nightclub, this place has bags of character, and is great for a bit of après ski partying late into the night.
