



San Cassiano is a charming, Italian ski resort and a great choice in the Dolomiti ski area. Quiet and refined, families will enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of the village. Part of the Alta Badia region, you'll have access to a vast ski area thanks to links with the neighbouring villages. Favoured by mixed-ability groups, the gentle runs with good sun exposure are enjoyed by all. Intermediates also have the option of accessing the Sellaronda ski area, with over 1100km of pistes included in your ski pass. The village is ideally located between La Villa & Cortina, giving you the option to explore the wider area. Boasting a scenic charm, even the ski lifts here are gentle, with guests enjoying the slower pace for the chance to soak in the views.

Top Runs

- Pralongià – The most beautiful run in the ski resort, the piste is drenched in sun, making for spectacular skiing.
- Piz Sorega – The longest run in the ski resort at La Villa, you can ski for over 8.5km at an elevation of 700m high.
- Gran Risa – A famous World Cup slope, this is the most challenging run in the area, perfect for an experienced skier to tackle.



Best for Après Ski

- **Da La Vedla**
With live music twice a week, this bar has a fantastic atmosphere for après. A firm favourite in the ski resort for this reason, delicious drinks and tasty pizzas are a real winner here.
- **La Sieia**
A self-titled 'pizzeria lounge bar', you can enjoy a few drinks here or perhaps even sit down for a meal, giving you the flexibility for both. Open until 11pm some evenings.
- **L'Murin (Corvara)**
A beautiful beer garden, this bar has a wonderfully landscaped outdoor seating area, so you can enjoy a pint whilst soaking in the Dolomite atmosphere. With a good selection on tap, this is a great après choice.
