Our View on Serre Chevalier





Serre Chevalier is a rustic mountain region surrounded by a collection of modern hamlets to old-style, traditional villages. Often considered as a 'hidden gem' in the Southern French Alps, Serre Chevalier is an excellent choice for skiers looking to cover vast terrain. The four villages that make up the ski resort, total more than 250km of piste and at its highest peak, reaches a ski altitude of 2,800m. With something to suit skiers and snowboarders of all abilities, it's the ideal ski resort for families and groups alike.

Best for Après Ski

- La Grotte
 - Located at the foot of the slopes, La Grotte is a lively venue. There's live music, DJs, a pool table and table football. It's a great spot to let loose after a day on the mountain.
- Blue Bird Cocktail Bar
 For something a little more sophisticated, this cocktail bar has a fantastic atmosphere.

 Select a delicious tipple from the varied menu and relax to the sound of funky jazz.
- The Sister's Pub
 Here you will find a classic
 Irish pub. Join for a quiz night,
 live music or a DJ set. The
 pub stays open until 2am with
 happy hours available too!
- Le ROYAL à Serre Chevalier
 A perfect slopeside spot
 to enjoy a beer in the late
 afternoon sun.

Top Runs

- For a lovely scenic run to warm up, take the Bachas chair from Monêtier and head down the Corvaria red run.
 Weave between the piste and the forest as you go.
- From Chantemerle, take the Ratier bubble lift and the Serre Chevalier bubble lift to one of the highest points of the ski resort. At the peak of almost 2,500m you will find magnificent views of the region.
- To practice your park skills, venture over to the Villeneuve section. Here skiers and snowboarders will find several jumps, boxes and hits to build freestyle flair.
