Top Runs

- Fasch This blue run is short but meanders quite a bit. There is also a scenic tree-lined section that includes embankments for anyone daring enough to jump.
- Rendl Talabfahrt This long red run boasts a variety of terrain and scenery, from narrow and wide sections to areas of freestyle skiing.
- Mattunjoch An off-piste route, this is one for those more experienced skiers looking for a daring challenge. The run takes you over cliffs and through challenging terrain.

- **Gasthof Valluga** This hotel has a restaurant that offers both local and international cuisine. You can retire to the hotel bar afterwards for a glass of wine or a delicious cocktail.
