
Our View on Warth-Schröcken





Warth-Schröcken is known for its brilliant snow record and diverse terrain. The Austrian ski resort has a peaceful atmosphere and fantastic skiing. The ski resort itself has 68km of pistes, but with a full Arlberg pass, you can access 305km of slopes linking to Lech, Zürs and St. Anton. You can admire the beautiful mountain scenery in the villages themselves. A lovely hidden gem within one of the largest ski areas in Austria.

Top Runs

- · There are dedicated children and practice areas near each village that are perfect for beginners.
- At the top of the Jägeralp-Express 6-man chairlift, there's a selection of blues to choose from. Perfect for those who are progressing from the nursery slopes.
- In Schröcken there is a nice relatively long red run descending from the Sonnen-Jet chairlift. This run has a couple of alternative routes to try too.
- Advanced skiers can try to complete the Run of Fame ski circuit. 85km of pistes stretching over the Arlberg ski area. It's one of the most legendary ski experiences in the Alps.





Best for Après Ski

- Chimney Bar Steffisalp Admire views of the outstanding Biberkopf mountain whilst enjoying a warm drink by the fire. A great way to end the day.
- A classic quiet pub where you can enjoy a cocktail or a beer. It's also a good place to watch live sport.
- Walserstube A modern looking bar that's perfect for a quiet drink in the evening. Located in the Hotel Walserstube opposite the Steffisalp Express lift.

Recommended Restaurants

- Wälder Metzge
 - For a classic alpine cheese fondue or local Austrian cuisine head to the Wälder Metzge.
- Punschhütte
 - Located in the middle of the ski area, this restaurant serves homemade strudel and leberkäse. It has a large sun terrace to enjoy the stunning mountain views.
- Burgermeisterei Steffisalp For the best burgers in town head to the Burgermeisterei. All the ingredients are freshly sourced. Enjoy burgers with an alpine twist.
- The Luxerei

Part of the Lux Alp Chalet you can enjoy Austrian specialities, fondue and the best pizza in town. The decor has a cosy mountain hut vibe.
